Report Cards will be distributed to students in grades 1-5 in December, March and June. Kindergarten students will receive their first Report Card in January.

Please adhere to the following:

MT: Meets grade level expectations.

N: Must be used in place of a failing grade.

NL: Must be used in cases where there is insufficient information to determine whether a student has met standards.

Final Grading Scale for June: Parents/Guardians make the final decision about whether the student's final passing grade remains on the existing scale or is updated to MT (Meets Standards).
